# Tennis Schedule

## Our Tennis Program

1. A one-time, up-front fee of \$75 per child for kids under 12 (who have 1 hour lessons) or \$100 per child for kids 13+ (who have 1½ hour lessons). This allows kids to take tennis lessons for six weeks at a substantial discount.
2. Adults who come to the Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday morning classes may pay a one-time fee of \$100.

Tennis lessons are held Monday through Thursday, from June 21 through July 30.

Please note that classes are age-based. The objectives are for kids to have fun, develop their tennis skills, and play tennis with kids their own age. If your child is involved in tennis programs during the school year, class adjustments can be made in consultation with Phil Campbell.

About 4 - 6 year olds/Adults class: Now with more adult classes, the adults can join the lessons led by Phil Campbell Monday through Thursdays. The 4 - 6 year olds have a regular tennis lesson with the assistant coaches.

HVSC Tennis Team: This is separate from the tennis lessons and is an additional \$25 fee and is for ages 10 - 18. For instruction, these players should sign up for age 13 and up. Includes Pro-organized play inter-club for the advanced players and intramural for the developing players. Matches are 1 - 3 pm or 2 - 4 pm on Fridays and includes a team T-shirt. Match sign-up is at the beginning of the week and is limited to the first 20 who sign-up.

Free Adult Tennis Social during the summer. Come out and join the fun. Refreshments are provided by the club. No tennis experience necessary. July 10 from 6-8pm

For more information, contact Phil Campbell, HVSC Tennis Pro, at (734) 846-4966. Private lessons are available with the Tennis Pro or his assistants. The fee is \$40/hour.

## Fees

The fee per child for either the swim or dive team is \$65 . Team members participating on both swim and dive teams will pay a total fee of \$90 . Swim or dive team members practicing with another organized practice group will pay a reduced swim team fee of \$40.

*Note: To participate in the swimming/diving championships (the week of July 26th), team members must have participated in at least two dual meets prior to championships. Championships are the most important (and most fun!) meets of the summer - please make every effort to have your child attend his/her championship meet. Coaches assume that all swimmers/divers will be present at a scheduled swim or dive meet unless the child has notified the coach of a planned absence by signing up on the "Missing-In-Action" list in the club office. It is important that the MIA list is signed ASAP, or at the latest, the Tuesday before the affected meet being missed, as this is when line-ups are being made for the upcoming meet. If unable to participate in Championships, please sign championship MIA folder before the start of the dual meet season. This commitment is very important to the team.*
